CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS

→ Breakfast Club – *A full belly is a happy belly!*

This program is offered to children of all ages. It operates during school days only. There are two separate sittings each morning with various nutritious foods being served for breakfast

→ After School Club – *It's up to them – it's their time!*

This club gives members a chance to spend time having fun. Children can spend one hour doing whatever they enjoy: crafts, playing games or playing on the computer.

→ Outdoor play – *Excess energy . . . been inside too long, needs some fresh air!*

Red Light Green Light . . . What time is it Mr. Wolf? ... Duck, Duck Goose . . . These are just some of the games we play. Children can join us for an hour-long, high-paced, fun-packed program. After the games, it's time for a craft, winding down in a fun way.

→ Homework Club – *Shhhhhh . . . this is a learning zone!*

The Homework Club is a chance for children to work in a quiet environment, doing their homework while receiving help from staff, volunteers or each other.

They spend about 30 – 40 minutes doing homework or other related educational work. The rest of the time is spent on crafts, playing games, or working on the computer.

→ School Readiness program – *A, B, C . . . it's as easy as 1, 2, 3!*

Start your children off on the right foot with the school readiness program. Participants will practice such things as the alphabet, colours, shapes, numbers, colouring and printing. They also enjoy story time, craft time and free play having fun at the same time.

→ Fun time for Preschoolers – *The social time of school readiness*

This program offers the preschooler a chance to work on their social skills in a group setting. They spend their time playing, singing, crafting. This is an exciting, jam-packed program full of fun.

→ **Youth volunteer program training – *Volunteering is fun for all!***

This is a chance for the teenage participants to have a hands-on approach with programming at the outreach centre. As a group, they develop and facilitate programs for the younger children.

→ **Special events – *Anytime can be a fun time!***

If it is a special day for all, we will have an event for everyone to participate. Christmas, National Child Day and End-of-School are a few examples.
