We are excited the government is moving cautiously into Phase 5 as of October 4th, 2021.

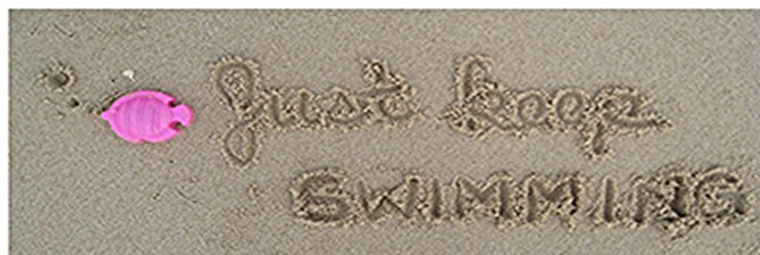
Family Resource Centres under our management will not be asking for proof of vaccination from participants when they attend programs at our centres.

Moving Forward:

The SSFRA will keep in place the following Public Health Measures to ensure the safety of all participants, staff, volunteers and partners accessing our programs and services:

- Mandatory masking for participants, staff, volunteers and partners entering our facilities/programs.
- Physical distancing
- Gathering limits
- Registration required for programs
- Screening protocol for anyone entering programs and services
- Information for Contact Tracing
