

What do I need to know?

There may be a short bus ride provided by the School Board as part of the program and this will require your permission. (See Registration form link on Transition to School website page)

We would like to take pictures of the children in the program that may be use for promotional purposes. We will require your permission. You may also be asked to give permission for us to share information about your child with the teacher. (See Registration form link on Transition to School website page)

Transportation and pickup

Parents will be responsible for the transportation of their child to and from the school. Ensure that we have all the names of persons able to pickup your child. Your child will only be released to those on our list.
